Maximum Student/Teacher Ratio Inspection of School Year 2018-2019

Why this Inspection? As mandated by 14 Del. C. §1705A(d), the Auditor's Office performed an inspection to ensure compliance with classroom sizes for grades Kindergarten through third grade for School Year 2018-2019.

In accordance with 14 Del. C. §1705A, no kindergarten through third grade classroom should exceed the one teacher per 22 student ratio. If a classroom does exceed the maximum student/teacher ratio, there should be at least one additional teacher or paraprofessional present or a waiver of this requirement must be approved by the School Board on or before December 1st of the school year.

During this inspection, it was determined that thirteen districts/charter schools exceeded the ratio and received appropriate approval from their Board. Additionally, fifteen districts/charter schools exceeded the ratio and appropriately supplemented with additional support in the classroom.
